3. A current resume.
4. Two current letters of recommendation. Acceptable letters should come from current or former professors, advisors, employers or supervisors.
5. A current official or unofficial transcript. Newly admitted UNC Charlotte students must submit transcripts from previously attended schools and colleges.
6. A copy of your schedule of classes for summer and/or fall semester.
7. A current copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid.

- Have experienced a cumulative gap in their education of five or more years (see #2 above);
- Be enrolled as a full or part-time student at UNC Charlotte in a minimum of 6 hours;
- Be an undergraduate pursuing a first baccalaureate degree;
- Demonstrate financial need by completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); briefly describe circumstances not reflected on the FAFSA and attach to the SAR (see #7 above);
- Show academic promise (maintain a 2.0 grade point average) and commitment to obtaining a degree;
- Anticipate workforce participation for a significant period of time subsequent to graduation;
- Preference will be given to newly matriculating students.

Selected applicants must be available for an interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee.
